Club rules for Casual Rounds

Under the new World Handicap System inputting your casual round scores to build up your playing history and handicap record is much easier and is encouraged.

We have enabled our handicap system to support this feature and you can all now use it. To use the system, you need to be registered with HowDidIDo.com.

BEFORE YOU PLAY:

On the PSI unit or the HDID app.

Login to HowDidIDo - Click on "Todays Golf" - Click "Sign Into" Casual Round

Play your round (9-hole or 18-hole) which must be done with a marker.

Your card must be signed by yourself and a "Marker" who must have a recognised handicap, and you must play to qualifying competition rules, so no preferred lies etc.

Once you have signed in you have committed to submit a score if you don't, we HAVE to penalise you (EGU rules) unless you provide us with a good reason.

ON COMPLETION OF YOUR ROUND:

Go back to Todays Golf, click "score entry" and input your score into the PSI unit or the HDID app

Then either leave your card in the box for committee inspection or take a photo of the signed card and email it to secretary@lesormesgolf.com.

Your handicap will automatically update at midnight on the day you submit your score. Please mark it very clearly as casual round so it doesn't get mixed up with any competition cards.

We will review, regularly via our software system (usually weekly), any scores which do not meet the above criteria will be deleted.

The England Golf App has now been updated to provide the same functionality and the ability to submit casual rounds on other courses, the arrangements above will continue to be applicable.
